**Dear Parent or Guardian,**

In the past there has been some confusion about the rules governing arrival and departure times at SYC events. The SYC rules state that once a person has arrived at the event, he or she should remain at the event until the end. That is for both their safety and our liability. This is why we hold car keys until the event is over.

Participants are expected to arrive at the specified time. In this busy world, sometimes there are events that come up that necessitate a late arrival or early departure, like a family wedding or mandatory sports event. However, we must be notified in advance and it must also be noted on the registration form if your teen will be coming late or leaving early. We must collect the full registration fee, even if your son or daughter does not attend the entire event.

If a participant does not send in or bring with them the proper signed forms, we do need to turn them away. Please discuss these rules with your son or daughter, and please feel free to address any questions you may have to any SYC/EC member or advisor.

2. Keys will be collected by an SYC advisor and will be secured for the duration of the event.
3. Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, fireworks, and pets are prohibited.
4. Anything of a sexual nature that you would feel embarrassed doing in front of your parents, or your pastor, is not allowed.

## Directions To Fall Convention:

If you are coming **from South of Pilgrim Lodge:**

From I-95: take exit 102, Turn Right onto Route 126 OR

From I-295: take exit 51, Turn Left onto Route 126.

Follow Route 126 about 2.5 miles.

Turn **RIGHT** onto Spears Corner Road at the blinking light

Continue **STRAIGHT** for 4.3 miles, (through 2 stop signs) and at the third stop sign (Careful: cross traffic does **NOT** stop at any of the three stop signs) turn **LEFT** onto Neck Road. Pilgrim Lodge will be **ONE MILE** ahead on your **RIGHT**.

If you are coming **from North of Pilgrim Lodge:**

From ME-95 take exit 109 B onto Route 202 west in Augusta.

Then Follow below:

If you are coming **from West of Pilgrim Lodge:**

Travel through Augusta on Route 202

You will cross over I-95

After 2.5 miles, (by the Manchester Texaco), at the stoplight where Rt. 17 turns right (don't turn right)

And Rt. 202 goes straight (don't go straight)

**TURN LEFT** onto Pond Road.

Follow Pond Road for about 6.5 miles.

Pilgrim Lodge will be on your **RIGHT**.
